For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-15-302(A) TO PROVIDE
8 THAT PERSONS LICENSED BY THE AUCTIONEER_S LICENSING BOARD
9 WHO HAVE FAILED TO RENEW THEIR LICENSE WITHIN A TWO (2)
10 YEAR PERIOD SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PASS THE WRITTEN
11 EXAMINATION OFFERED BY THE BOARD BEFORE A NEW LICENSE MAY
12 BE ISSUED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-15-302(a) AND
16 TO REQUIRE RE-EXAMINATION FOR PERSONS
17 WHO HAVE FAILED TO RENEW THEIR
18 AUCTIONEER_S LICENSE WITHIN A TWO (2)
19 YEAR PERIOD."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-15-302(a) is hereby amended to read as
25 follows:

26 "(a)(1) No examination shall be required for the renewal of any
27 present or future license, unless such license has been revoked. In this
28 case, the applicant shall take and pass the written examination offered by
29 the board before a new license may be issued.

30 (2) Licensed auctioneers have a ninety-day grace period beyond a
31 renewal date to renew a license.

32 (3) Penalty for late renewals will be two (2) times the sum of a
33 normal license renewal fee.

34 (4) If an auctioneer fails to renew his license under this
35 section for a period of three (3) years or more, the holder of the invalid

1 license may be issued a new license only upon taking and passing the written
2 examination offered by the board."

3

4 SECTION 2. Effective date. This amendment shall become effective on
5 October 1, 1995, and shall apply retroactively.

6

7 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

10

11 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
12 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
13 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
15 act are declared to be severable.

16

17 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
18 hereby repealed.
