HOUSE BILL 1982

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 21, CHAPTER 8,
SUBCHAPTER 6 CONCERNING FORMER MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY WHO BECOME REGISTERED LOBBYISTS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT CONCERNING FORMER MEMBERS OF THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY WHO BECOME REGISTERED
LOBBYISTS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapter 8, Subchapter 6 is amended
by adding the following new section:

"21-8-609. Restriction on former legislators as lobbyists.

Beginning January 1, 1999, a former member of the House of
Representatives or Senate of the Arkansas General Assembly is ineligible to
be a registered lobbyist for two (2) years after the end of his or her term
of office."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
