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## 7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE BREAST CANCER  
9 CONTROL PROGRAM FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE  
10 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

## 13 Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH  
15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19         SECTION 1. *REGULAR SALARIES.* There is hereby established for the  
20 Department of Health for the Breast Cancer Control Program for the 1995-97  
21 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries  
22 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
23 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and  
24 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
25 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
26 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
27 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
28 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
29 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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8           SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
 9 Department of Health, to be payable from the Breast Cancer Control Fund, for  
 10 personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Health - Breast  
 11 Cancer Control Program for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the  
 12 following:

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27           SECTION 3. Further, the balance of the funds and appropriations as  
 28 provided in this Section for the administration of the Breast Cancer Control  
 29 Program which remain on June 30, 1996 shall be carried forward and made  
 30 available for the same purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997.

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32           SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 33 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 35 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7         SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
10 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16         SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
17 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
18 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20         SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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26         SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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29         SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
30 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
31 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;  
32 that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the  
33 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are  
34 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the  
35 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work

1 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
2 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
3 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
4 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after  
5 July 1, 1995.
