7 For An Act To Be Entitled 8 "AN ACT TO LIMIT DAMAGES WHICH MAY BE AWARDED TO AN 9 UNINSURED DRIVER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

11 Subtitle

12 "TO LIMIT DAMAGES WHICH MAY BE AWARDED
13 TO AN UNINSURED DRIVER"

14

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. Liability for injury to operator who fails to maintain
18 financial responsibility.

19 (a) A person may not obtain noneconomic damages or punitive damages in
20 a civil action for bodily injury, death, or damage to or destruction of
21 property arising out of a motor vehicle accident if, at the time of the
22 accident, the person:

23 (1) was the operator of a motor vehicle involved in the accident;
24 and

25 (2) was operating the motor vehicle in violation of Arkansas Code
26 § 27-22-104.

27 (b) For purposes of this act, noneconomic damages means damages to
28 compensate the operator for a loss other than a pecuniary loss, including,
29 but not limited to, damages for pain and suffering, mental anguish, loss
30 associated with disfigurement, and loss of companionship or consortium.

31

32 SECTION 2. This act applies only to a cause of action that accrues on
33 or after the effective date of this act. An action that accrued before the
34 effective date of this act is governed by the law applicable to the action
35 immediately before the effective date of this act, and that law is continued

1 in effect for that purpose.

2

3 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
4 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
5 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

6

7 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.

12

13 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
14 hereby repealed.
