15        BASED WASTE IN THE DEFINITION OF

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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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20       SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-52-425 is amended to read as follows:  
21       "§ 26-52-425. *Substitute fuel for manufacturing.*

22       There is specifically exempted from the tax imposed by §§ 26-52-301 and  
23 26-52-302, the following:

24       The gross receipts or gross proceeds derived from the sale of  
25 *substitute fuel used in producing, manufacturing, fabricating, assembling,*  
26 *processing, finishing, or packaging of articles of commerce at manufacturing*  
27 *or processing plants or facilities in the State of Arkansas. The terms*  
28 *\_manufacturing\_ or \_processing\_ shall have the same meaning as set out in §*  
29 *26-52-402(b). The term \_substitute fuel\_ shall mean products or materials*  
30 *which have been derived from tires, from municipal or other solid waste, from*  
31 *used motor oil, or from petroleum based waste, for use to produce heat or*  
32 *power by burning; provided however that the term 'solid waste' shall be*  
33 *strictly construed to only include waste as commonly understood on the date*  
34 *of enactment, excluding solid wood chips and other wood by-products."*

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1        SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
2 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
3 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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5        SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
9 act are declared to be severable.

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11        SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
12 hereby repealed.
