7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 14-51-206 TO PROVIDE THAT
8 A CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION MAY APPOINT ITS OWN ATTORNEY,
9 IF IT DESIRES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

11 "TO PROVIDE THAT A CIVIL SERVICE
12 COMMISSION MAY APPOINT ITS OWN ATTORNEY,
13 IF IT DESIRES."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-51-206 is amended to read as follows:
18 "14-51-206. Attorney for commission and city.

19 (a) Except if the commission decides otherwise, the city attorney
20 shall act as attorney for the commission in all trials or other legal
21 transactions. Provided, the commission may appoint an attorney to represent
22 the commission if it so desires.

23 (b) The city shall hire, on an annual basis, independent legal counsel
24 to represent the city and the department head when the city's managerial
25 employment decisions are brought for review before the commission and in all
26 trials, proceedings, or other legal transactions before the commission."

27

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31

32 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

4

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
