8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE - VOTER
10 REGISTRATION SYSTEM FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE
11 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE
15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM. There is
20 hereby established for the Secretary of State - Voter Registration System for
21 the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
22 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification
23 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,
24 and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to
25 which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be
26 exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation
27 Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed
28 by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act
29 (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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8 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM. There is hereby

9 appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the State Central

10 Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Secretary

11 of State - Voter Registration System for the biennial period ending June 30,

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27 SECTION 3. CARRY FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending

28 June 30, 1996, any unexpended appropriation and funds provided in Item

29 (03)(D) of Section 2 shall be carried forward and made available for the same

30 purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997.

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32 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

33 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

35 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
10 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
17 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
18 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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26 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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29 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
30 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
31 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;
32 that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the
33 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
34 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
35 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work

1 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
2 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
3 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
4 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
5 July 1, 1995.
