HOUSE BILL 2037

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT WHEN ANY TWO-LANE STATE HIGHWAY IS
9 EXPANDED TO A FOUR-LANE WITHIN CITY LIMITS THE HIGHWAY
10 DEPARTMENT SHALL CURB AND GUTTER THE PROPERTY ALONG THE
11 HIGHWAY IN THE SAME MANNER THROUGHOUT THE CITY; AND FOR
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "PROVIDE THAT WHEN ANY TWO-LANE STATE
16 HIGHWAY IS EXPANDED TO A FOUR-LANE
17 WITHIN CITY LIMITS THE HIGHWAY
18 DEPARTMENT SHALL CURB AND GUTTER THE
19 PROPERTY ALONG THE HIGHWAY EQUALLY
20 THROUGHOUT THE CITY."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. When any two-lane state highway is expanded to a four-lane
25 state highway and the expansion project includes an area within the
26 boundaries of any city of the first class or second class or incorporated
27 town, the State Highway and Transportation Department shall curb and gutter
28 along the highway in a uniform manner throughout the length of the project
29 within the city limits.

31 SECTION 2. This act applies to highway construction in progress or
32 which occurs hereafter.

34 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.

11

12 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
13 General Assembly that when a two lane state highway is expanded to a four
14 lane state highway within the city limits that the property should be treated
15 equally within the city limits as to installation of curbs and gutters; that
16 this act so provides; and that this act should go into effect immediately in
17 order to correct inequities as soon as possible. Therefore, an emergency is
18 hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate
19 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
20 and effect from and after its passage and approval.
