8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF MEDICAL ASSISTANTS BY  
9 PHYSICIANS LICENSED BY THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD;  
10 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF MEDICAL  
14 ASSISTANTS BY PHYSICIANS LICENSED BY THE  
15 ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD"

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Definition. As used in this act, "medical assistant" means  
20 a professional multiskilled person dedicated to assisting in all aspects of  
21 medical practice under the direct responsibility of a physician licensed to  
22 practice medicine by the Arkansas State Medical Board. This practitioner  
23 assists with patient care management, executes administrative and clinical  
24 procedures, and often performs managerial and supervisory functions.  
25 Competence in the field also requires that a medical assistant adhere to  
26 ethical and legal standards of professional practice, recognize and respond  
27 to emergencies and demonstrate professional characteristics.

28

29 SECTION 2. Duties. Under the direct responsibility of a licensed  
30 physician the duties of a medical assistant are to:

31 (a) Perform clinical procedures, to include:  
32 (1) Assist with aseptic procedures;  
33 (2) Taking vital signs;  
34 (3) Preparing patients for the physician's care;  
35 (4) Venipunctures and nonintravenous injections, limited to

1 subcutaneous and intranocula injections;  
2                 (5) Observing and reporting patients\_ signs or symptoms;  
3         (b) Administering basic first aid.  
4         (c) Assist with patient examinations or treatments.  
5         (d) Operating office medical equipment.  
6         (e) Collecting routine laboratory specimens as directed by the  
7 physician.  
8         (f) Administer medication as directed by the physician.  
9         (g) Perform basic laboratory procedures as permitted by federal law.  
10         (h) Perform office procedures including all general administrative  
11 duties required by the physician.

12  
13                 SECTION 3. Certification. Medical assistants may be certified by the  
14 American Association of Medical Assistants or as a Registered Medical  
15 Assistant by the American Society of Medical Technologists.

16  
17                 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
18 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
19 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

20  
21                 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
22 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
23 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
24 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
25 act are declared to be severable.

26  
27                 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
28 hereby repealed.
