7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION ON CHILD ABUSE, RAPE
9 AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TO ESTABLISH CRITERIA, TRAINING AND
10 CERTIFICATION FOR PROVIDERS OF COURT AND POST-PRISON
11 TRANSFER BOARD MANDATED SEX OFFENDER TREATMENT; AND FOR
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

14 Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION ON
16 CHILD ABUSE, RAPE AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
17 TO ESTABLISH CRITERIA, TRAINING AND
18 CERTIFICATION FOR PROVIDERS OF COURT AND
19 POST-PRISON TRANSFER BOARD MANDATED SEX
20 OFFENDER TREATMENT."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 SECTION 1. (a) The Commission on Child Abuse, Rape and Domestic
25 Violence is authorized to establish educational, specialized training and
26 experience criteria for individuals holding themselves out as providers of
27 sex offender treatment.

28 (b) These criteria are to be developed through consultation with the
29 professional associations representing service providers who usually provide
30 such services, and are in no way intended to interfere with or usurp the
31 prerogatives of any professional board of commission.

32

33 SECTION 2. The Commission on Child Abuse, Rape and Domestic Violence
34 is authorized to develop and sponsor training and work experience for
35 professionals seeking to meet the criteria established in Section 1.

2 SECTION 3. The Commission on Child Abuse, Rape and Domestic Violence
3 will provide courts, the Post-Prison Transfer Board and the Department of
4 Community Punishment with lists of providers who are in process of, or are
5 currently, meeting the criteria established in Section 1.

7 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

10

11 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
12 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
13 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
15 act are declared to be severable.

16

17 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
18 hereby repealed.
