12 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE A SECRETARY FOR THE
13 CIRCUIT AND CHANCERY JUDGES OF PHILLIPS
14 COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Phillips County shall hereafter provide a secretary for the
20 circuit and chancery judges in Phillips County.

21

22 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
23 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
24 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

25

26 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
27 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
28 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
29 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
30 act are declared to be severable.

31

32 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
33 hereby repealed.

34

35 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the

1 General Assembly that the caseload of the circuit and chancery judges of
2 Phillips is such that a secretary should be provided and that this act
3 creates a position of secretary for those judges. Therefore, an emergency is
4 hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate
5 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
6 and effect from and after its passage and approval.
