HOUSE BILL 2139

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF DANCE
INSTRUCTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF
DANCE INSTRUCTION"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Hereafter dance instruction shall only be performed in this state by dance instructors who are certified by a nationally or internationally recognized dance organization.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
