## 7 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

8 REQUESTING THAT THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA ON TAIWAN BE  
9 CONSIDERED FOR AND GRANTED FULL MEMBERSHIP STATUS IN THE  
10 UNITED NATIONS.

13 REQUESTING THAT THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA ON TAIWAN BE  
14 CONSIDERED FOR AND GRANTED FULL MEMBERSHIP STATUS IN THE  
15 UNITED NATIONS.

17 WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas enjoys a sister state relationship with  
18 the Province of Taiwan, Republic of China; and

19 WHEREAS, the volume of commercial relations between Arkansas and the  
20 Republic of China on Taiwan has grown steadily during the past few years; and

21 WHEREAS, the Republic of China on Taiwan is the world's fourth largest  
22 buyer of Arkansas products; and

23 WHEREAS, Arkansas exports to the Republic of China on Taiwan in 1993  
24 exceeded 61 million dollars; and

25 WHEREAS, the Republic of China on Taiwan is now the 14th largest  
26 trading nation in the world, and ranks 7th in outbound investment, 20th in  
27 gross national product, and 25th in per capita income; and

28 WHEREAS, the population of the Republic of China on Taiwan is larger  
29 than that of two-thirds of the member nations of the United Nations; and

30 WHEREAS, the Republic of China on Taiwan has consistently demonstrated  
31 her support for democracy and peace in the world, her concern for regional  
32 and international development, and her interest in overseas relief programs;  
33 and

34 WHEREAS, seven Central American countries have proposed to the United  
35 Nations to establish an ad hoc committee to study and analyze the exceptional

1 situation of the Republic of China on Taiwan in the international community  
2 so as to find a fair and feasible solution to the issue of her participation  
3 in the framework of the United Nations,

5 **NOW THEREFORE,**

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL  
7 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

8

9 That the people of the Republic of China on Taiwan deserve appropriate  
10 recognition and credit as dynamic, peaceful and productive participants in  
11 the international community.

12 That the Republic of China on Taiwan deserves to be considered for full  
13 membership status in the United Nations and all the affiliated organizations.

14 That the United States Government give due consideration to render her  
15 active support to an important trade partner and former ally so as to  
16 expedite the full participation of the Republic of China in the international  
17 community in general and the United Nations in particular.

18 That copies of this resolution be distributed to the Ambassador for the  
19 Republic of China on Taiwan to the United States, the General Assembly of the  
20 United Nations, the United States delegation of the United Nations, the Trade  
21 Representative of the United States, and to the State Department of the  
22 United States.
