WHEREAS, the chiropractic profession was founded on September 18, 1895

by Daniel David Palmer in Davenport, Iowa in the United States of America,

and will therefore celebrate its centennial on September 18, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the profession of chiropractic is now practiced by doctors of

chiropractic throughout the world, including 50,000 in the United States of

America; and

WHEREAS, contemporary standards in chiropractic education, research and

practice have led to ever broadening acceptance of the benefits of

chiropractic health care by the public and the health care community; and

WHEREAS, each year millions of Americans now choose chiropractic health

care for the restoration and maintenance of their health by natural methods

and without the use of drugs or surgery,
