RELATING TO THE UNITED STATES MILITARY FORCES AND THE

17 WHEREAS, President Clinton has affirmed that his foreign policy
18 regarding the deployment of United States military forces under the authority
19 of the United Nations will bear little change from that of his predecessor;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, the constitutional role of the United States military is to
22 protect the life, liberty, and property of United States citizens and to
23 defend our nation against insurrection or foreign invasion; and

24 WHEREAS, the United States is an independent sovereign nation and not a
25 tributary of the United Nations; and

26 WHEREAS, there is no popular support for the establishment of a "new
27 world order" or world sovereignty of any kind either under the United Nations
28 or under any world body in any form of global government; and

29 WHEREAS, global government would mean the destruction of our
30 Constitution and corruption of the spirit of the Declaration of Independence,
31 our freedom, and our way of life.

33 NOW THEREFORE,

34 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL

35 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the United States Congress is hereby memorialized to:

1. Cease the appropriation of United States funds for any military activity not authorized by Congress;

2. Cease engagement in any military activity under the authority of the United Nations or any world body;

3. Cease the rendering of aid to any activity or engagement under the jurisdiction of the United Nations or any world body; and

4. Cease any support for the establishment of a "new world order" or to any form of global government.

THAT the United States Congress is hereby memorialized to refrain from taking any further steps toward the economic or political merger of the United States into a world body or any form of world government.

THAT this resolution shall be sent to the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, the Secretary of the United States Senate, and to each member of the Arkansas Congressional Delegation by the Chief Clerk of the Arkansas House of Representatives.
