18 WHEREAS, Section 17 of Article V of the Constitution of the state of  
19 Arkansas provides that the regular biennial session of the General Assembly  
20 shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless extended by a vote of  
21 two-thirds of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

22 WHEREAS, it now appears that the regular session of the Eightieth  
23 General Assembly will be unable to complete the essential business of this  
24 session within sixty days, and that an extension of this regular session will  
25 be necessary for the completion of the business of this session,

28 NOW THEREFORE,

29 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL  
30 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

32 That the regular session of the Eightieth General Assembly of the state  
33 of Arkansas is hereby extended through the close of business in each house on  
34 Friday, March 31, 1995, at which time the 1995 regular session shall be  
35 adjourned sine die unless it is determined that a further extension is

1 necessary to complete the business of the session.
