17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
19 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

21 That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the
22 Constitution of the state of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the
23 electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election
24 for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting
25 thereon at such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part
26 of the Constitution of the state of Arkansas, to wit:

28 "SECTION 1. The office of constable is hereby abolished effective
29 January 1, 1997.

30
31 SECTION 2. Section 47 of Article 7 of the Arkansas Constitution is
32 hereby repealed.

34 SECTION 3. This amendment shall become effective on January 1, 1997."
