WHEREAS, the achievements of United States Senator J. William Fulbright
14 earned him deserved recognition as an outstanding citizen of the world; and

WHEREAS, the Fayetteville, Arkansas native, at 34, became the youngest
16 college president in the United States when he was selected president of the
17 University of Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, his distinguished service in the U.S. Senate for 30 years was
19 marked by the courage of his conviction to speak out in opposition to popular
20 opinion; and

WHEREAS, Senator Fulbright was chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations
22 Committee for a longer period than anyone in history and became influential
23 throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, his establishment of the Fulbright Scholarship Program has
25 fostered peaceful exchange of students from throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, after leaving the Senate, he continued to serve as a counselor
27 to presidents and leaders in foreign policy; and
