14 earned him deserved recognition as an outstanding citizen of the world; and

15 WHEREAS, the Fayetteville, Arkansas native, at 34, became the youngest  
16 college president in the United States when he was selected president of the  
17 University of Arkansas; and

18 WHEREAS, his distinguished service in the U.S. Senate for 30 years was  
19 marked by the courage of his conviction to speak out in opposition to popular  
20 opinion; and

21 WHEREAS, Senator Fulbright was chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations  
22 Committee for a longer period than anyone in history and became influential  
23 throughout the world; and
