8 IN RESPECTFUL MEMORY OF DR. MATT LOCKE ELLIS.

11 IN RESPECTFUL MEMORY OF DR. MATT LOCKE ELLIS.

13 WHEREAS, the achievements of Dr. Matt Locke Ellis brought him  
14 recognition throughout the state as a prominent figure in higher education  
15 and a devout Methodist whose friendships spanned every strata of society; and  
16

17 WHEREAS, the native of Southeast Arkansas served as president of  
18 Henderson State Teachers College in Arkadelphia from 1941 to 1945, where he  
19 earned the distinction of being the only person to serve as professor,  
20 academic dean, and president; and

21

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Ellis also served as president of Hendrix College in  
23 Conway from 1945 to 1958, during which time the college's endowment doubled  
24 and a chapel, auditorium, dining hall, student center, and two resident halls  
25 were either built or started; and

27 WHEREAS, in 1958 Dr. Ellis was selected as Arkansas Man of the Year by  
28 readers of the Arkansas Democrat; and

30 WHEREAS, in 1987 the Henderson State University Board of Trustees  
31 established the Matt Locke Ellis College of Arts and Sciences in his honor;

34 WHEREAS, Dr. Ellis was also a lay leader in the Methodist Church,  
35 serving in both the Little Rock and North Arkansas Conferences and as a

1 delegate to the Methodist Church's General Conference,

3 NOW THEREFORE,

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL

5 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
