15 URGING THE ARKANSAS SCHOOL-TO-WORK OPPORTUNITIES TASK
16 FORCE, HEADS OF VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES, AND THE BUSINESS
17 AND INDUSTRIAL COMMUNITY TO WORK TOGETHER IN IMPLEMENTING
18 SCHOOL-TO-WORK OPPORTUNITIES.

20 WHEREAS, the School-To-Work initiative is part of a broad-based and
21 growing interest across the United States in creating a school-to-work system
22 to help young Americans make the transition from high school to career-
23 oriented work or to further education; and

25 WHEREAS, the federal School-To-Work Opportunities Act of 1993 has
26 provided an initial grant for planning and developing a statewide school-to-
27 work system in Arkansas, with possibilities of more grants in the future; and

29 WHEREAS, Governor Jim Guy Tucker has shown his commitment to furthering
30 the School-To-Work initiative in Arkansas by appointing a School-To-Work
31 Opportunities Task Force; and

33 WHEREAS, business, labor, education, and government will all play a key
34 role in the development and implementation of a school-to-work system in
35 Arkansas; and

2 WHEREAS, cooperation is necessary to provide a comprehensive and
3 coherent system for helping students make an effective transition from
4 school-to-work.

6 NOW THEREFORE,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL
8 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

10 THAT the Eightieth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas urges the
11 members of the School-To-Work Opportunities Task Force, the heads of various
12 state agencies, and members of the business and industrial community to work
13 together for all young Arkansans by implementing the Arkansas School-To-Work
