17 WHEREAS, Ms. Stephanie Shearman, a seventh grader at Valley View Junior  
18 High School, competed in a 5K race on the campus of Arkansas State University  
19 on October 22, 1994, and during the race witnessed another runner, 52-year  
20 old John Baker, collapse; and

22 WHEREAS, Stephanie, who was 12 years old at the time, administered  
23 cardiopulmonary resuscitation which successfully revived Mr. Baker and kept  
24 him alive until medical personnel transported him to St. Bernard's Regional  
25 Medical Center where he later underwent a quadruple coronary bypass  
26 operation; and

28 WHEREAS, Stephanie acted with incredible speed, skill, confidence and a  
29 cool head; and

31 WHEREAS, Stephanie learned CPR by taking a course through the American  
32 Red Cross; and

34 WHEREAS, Stephanie has received national attention and the incident  
35 will be re-enacted on the nationally televised program "Rescue 911".

2 NOW THEREFORE,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL  
4 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

6 That Ms. Stephanie Shearman is here commended for her display of  
7 phenomenal maturity and ability when administering CPR during a 5K race on  
8 October 22, 1994, which resulted in saving the life of one of her fellow  
9 runners.
