19 restriction on academic freedom is that an instructor's teaching have some
20 basis in science; and

22 *WHEREAS, conservative ideas and philosophies are often under*
23 *represented in our state's institutions of learning; and*

25 WHEREAS, the people of the state of Arkansas wish and desire that a
26 balanced treatment be given to the points of view *expressed* in our state_s
27 institutions of learning,

30 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL
31 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
