19 WHEREAS, in 1919 the Sixty-Sixth Congress of the United States
20 submitted the Nineteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution to the
21 legislatures of the several states, and Arkansas quickly joined to ratify the
22 same which states that "The right of citizens of the United States to vote
23 shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by a state on account
24 of sex"; and

26 WHEREAS, the Nineteenth Amendment gave women the right to vote and
27 empowered organizations such as the League of Women Voters, and that power
28 has been exercised over the past three-quarters of a century to mold this
29 country into the symbol of democracy, justice, and equal treatment before the
30 law; and

32 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters has been, and remains, an
33 organization striving for progressive change in government, and is ever
34 vigilant in its attempts to foster and protect fundamental fairness, equity,
35 and justice; and
