8 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDS HOUSE RULE 63. DEALING
9 WITH THE HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE TO CHANGE THE SUBJECT-
10 MATTERS WHICH ARE TO BE REFERRED TO THE COMMITTEE.

13 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDS HOUSE RULE 63. DEALING
14 WITH THE HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE.

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 THAT the House of Representatives of the Eightieth General Assembly of
20 the State of Arkansas amends the House Rules approved for the 1995 Regular
21 Session as follows:

22 "63. (a) Committee on Rules:

23 (1) All proposed action touching the rules, joint rules, and
24 order of business shall be referred to the Committee on Rules.

25 (2) It shall always be in order to call up, for consideration, a
26 report from the Committee on Rules.

27 (3) The Committee on Rules shall present to the House reports
28 concerning rules, joint rules, and order of business on the third day after
29 convening of the House. The permanent rules shall be adopted by a majority
30 of the members and thereafter they may be changed only by a vote of
31 sixty-seven (67) members.

32 (4) The Speaker shall refer to the Committee on Rules, any
33 matters dealing with lobbying, code of ethics, and similar legislation.

34 (5) Rules of the preceding General Assembly shall automatically
35 be adopted as temporary rules of the current assembly and may be amended or

1 suspended by a majority vote of the membership."
