19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTIETH GENERAL

20 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. The rules of the House of Representatives of the Eightieth  
23 General Assembly are amended by adding the following Rule:

24 "Each member of the House who is serving a first or second term in the  
25 House shall be entitled to serve as a non-voting member of one of the ten  
26 joint interim committees designated as "A" and "B" committees. The non-  
27 voting members of each of the ten joint interim committees shall be selected  
28 by the four House caucuses at a time designated by the Speaker sometime  
29 before the adjournment of each regular session. Each caucus shall select not  
30 to exceed three (3) first or second term members to serve as non-voting  
31 members of each of the ten joint interim committees designated as "A" and "B"  
32 committees. The non-voting members shall be entitled to attend meetings of  
33 the committees, to serve on subcommittees of the committee, to participate in  
34 the deliberations of the committee or subcommittee, and to receive per diem  
35 and mileage for attending meetings of the committee or subcommittee but shall

1 not have a vote in the committee or a subcommittee."
