21 world's largest manufacturer of hematology equipment and is located in Miami,

25 Principle, which is a highly technical method for counting and sizing
26 microscopic particles in blood and which is used by ninety-five percent (95%)

30 areas as cancer, AIDS, tissue transplant rejection, and DNA content; and

34 philosophy; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Wallace Coulter and Mr. Joe Coulter recently donated a
2 top-of-the line laboratory blood-testing system to the McGehee-Desha County
3 Hospital in fond memories of growing up in McGehee,
