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For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING EXPENSES
9 FOR THE STATE BOARD OF DISEASE INTERVENTION SPECIALISTS
10 WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL TO OTHER FUNDS WHICH MAY BE
11 APPROPRIATED DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1995;
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE STATE BOARD OF DISEASE
16 INTERVENTION SPECIALISTS SUPPLEMENTAL
17 APPROPRIATION."

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State
22 Board of Disease Intervention Specialists, to be payable from cash funds as
23 defined by Arkansas Code §19-4-801 of the State Board of Disease Intervention
24 Specialists, for operating expenses of the State Board of Disease
25 Intervention Specialists which shall be supplemental and in addition to other
26 funds which may be appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the
27 following:

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2 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
3 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
5 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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12 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
14 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
15 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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21 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
22 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
23 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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25 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
26 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
27 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
28 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
29 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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31 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
32 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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34 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
35 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for

1 the operations of the State Board of Disease Intervention Specialists are,
2 due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the State Board of Disease
3 Intervention Specialists to continue to provide essential governmental
4 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies
5 for the State Board of Disease Intervention Specialists to continue such
6 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
7 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
8 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
9 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the
11 date of its passage and approval.
