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7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO PAY THE SALARIES AND
9 EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNOR'S LEGISLATIVE LIAISONS AND
10 LEGISLATIVE CLERK DURING THE EIGHTIETH SESSION OF THE
11 ARKANSAS GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR AN APPROPRIATION FOR SALARIES AND EXPENSES OF
15 THE GOVERNOR'S LEGISLATIVE LIAISONS AND LEGISLATIVE
16 CLERK."

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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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20 SECTION 1. EXTRA HELP . There is hereby authorized, for the Office of
21 the Governor - Legislative Liaison Staff for the fiscal year ending June 30,
22 1995, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be
23 known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such
24 purposes on a weekly basis:

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32 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS . There is hereby appropriated, to the
33 Governor's Office, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund,
34 for personal services and operating expenses for the Office of the Governor
35 - Legislative Liaison Staff for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the

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8 SECTION 3. The Governor is hereby authorized to employ six (6)
 9 Legislative Liaisons who shall serve without pay but shall be entitled to per
 10 diem of up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each day the General Assembly
 11 is in regular session. After receiving approval of the Governor, the
 12 Department of Finance and Administration - Management Services Division is
 13 hereby authorized to process payments to said Liaisons from funds authorized
 14 by this Act.

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16 SECTION 4. PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND PER DIEM. Salaries and per diem as
 17 authorized in Sections 1 and 3 of this Act shall be in effect from and after
 18 January 9, 1995.

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20 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 21 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 23 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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30 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 32 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 33 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
2 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
5 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
6 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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8 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
9 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
10 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
11 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
12 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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14 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
15 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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17 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
18 the Eightieth General Assembly, that monies were not provided by the Seventy-
19 Ninth General Assembly to pay the salary and expenses of Legislative Liaisons
20 and Clerk needed by the Governor to effectively carry out the duties of the
21 office, that the services so provided are essential to provide effective
22 coordination between the Governor's Office and the General Assembly; that the
23 provisions of this Act will provide the necessary monies for such salaries
24 and expenses; and that the delay in the effective date of this Act could work
25 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision for essential
26 governmental services. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
27 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
28 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its
29 passage and approval.

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
