9 CONTRACTORS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER

14 "AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATUS OF
15 NEWSPAPER CARRIERS AS INDEPENDENT
16 CONTRACTORS."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 11-10-210 (f)(16)(A), concerning services not
21 included as employment, is amended to read as follows:

22 "(A) Service performed by an individual in the delivery or
23 distribution of newspapers or shopping news, not including delivery or
24 distribution to any point for subsequent delivery or distribution;"

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
27 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
28 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.

2 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
3 hereby repealed.

4

5 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
6 Assembly that newspaper carriers have traditionally been considered to be
7 independent contractors; that the Employment Security Department's
8 interpretation of the laws concerning independent contractors has called into
9 question whether many newspaper carriers are employees or independent
10 contractors; that many small newspapers will be harmed, if newspaper carriers
11 are interpreted to be employees; that this act exempts newspaper carriers
12 from employment status; that this act is immediately necessary in order to
13 preserve the independent contractor status of newspaper carriers and to avoid
14 unnecessary harm to newspaper companies. Therefore an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist and this act, being necessary for the immediate
16 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall be in full force
17 and effect upon passage and approval.
