18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. *It is hereby declared to be the policy of the state of*
21 *Arkansas that state agencies make improvements only upon land owned by the*
22 *state and to avoid making improvements on property not owned by the state*
23 *unless circumstances exist that would justify the decision of a state agency*
24 *to make permanent improvements to property it does not own. Circumstances*
25 *that may justify such improvements include but are not limited to:*

26 (1) *long term leases of twenty-five (25) years or more;*

27 (2) *donations of the use of the land to the state for a period of at*
28 *least twenty-five (25) years;*

29 (3) *the land is owned by another governmental agency; or*

30 (4) *the improvement will result in an overall advantageous economic,*
31 *conservation, or historical preservation benefit to the state of Arkansas.*

32 *The provisions of this act do not apply to land currently under lease*
33 *to the state.*

34

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
36 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
37 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
6 act are declared to be severable.

7

8 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
9 hereby repealed.
