Subtitle

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"AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR
APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the Office of the Governor for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

 14 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3)
 15 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
 16 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 17 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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19 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 20 to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the State Central Services
 21 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the
 22 Governor for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

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5 SECTION 7. TRANSFER PROVISIONS. Any unexpended balance of
6 appropriation provided in this Act, excluding Regular Salaries, which remains
7 at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be transferred
8 forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending
9 June 30, 1997.

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11 SECTION 8. On those days that the commission members shall be called
12 upon to perform actual duties or attend Vo-Tech Advisory Council meetings,
13 each member shall be reimbursed for actual travel expenses and mileage at the
14 established state rate.

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16 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
17 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
19 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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26 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
28 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
29 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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35 SECTION 11. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and

1 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
2 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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4 SECTION 12. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
5 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
6 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
7 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
8 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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10 SECTION 13. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
11 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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13 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
14 the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
15 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
16 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to
17 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
18 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
19 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
20 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
21 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
22 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
23 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
24 July 1, 1995.

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
