7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARIES OF THE SECRETARY-COURT
9 REPORTER-CASE COORDINATORS OF THE FOURTH JUDICIAL
10 DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARIES OF THE
14 SECRETARY-COURT REPORTER-CASE
15 COORDINATORS OF THE FOURTH JUDICIAL
16 DISTRICT."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-13-1204 is amended to read as follows:

21 "§ 16-13-1204. Secretary-court reporter-case coordinators.

22 (a) The chancellors, circuit judges, and circuit-chancery judges of
23 the Fourth Judicial District may each employ one (1) secretary-court
24 reporter-case coordinator to perform such duties as may be assigned by the
25 respective judges.

26 (b) The secretaries authorized by this section shall be appointed by
27 the respective judges, shall be sworn officers of the court, and each shall
28 hold office at the discretion of and during the term of the judge who
29 appointed him, except that he may be dismissed for incompetency, neglect of
30 duty, or misbehavior.

31 (c) The secretaries authorized by this section shall each be paid a
32 salary for calendar year 1995 of twenty-three thousand four hundred ninety-
33 five dollars (\$23,495) and an annual salary each year thereafter of twenty-
34 four thousand four hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$24,458), payable by the
35 counties comprising the Fourth Judicial District. The salaries shall be

1 apportioned between the two (2) counties on the basis of the assessed value
2 of property in the counties, which is determined to be ninety-three and
3 one-half percent (93.5%) for Washington County and six and one-half percent
4 (6.5%) for Madison County, and in the following amounts:

9 (d) The salaries shall be payable in twenty-six (26) equal
10 installments by the paying offices of the respective counties.

11 (e) The provisions of this section and the salaries prescribed herein
12 shall be retroactive to January 1, 1995."

14 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
15 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
16 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

17

18 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
19 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
20 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
21 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
22 act are declared to be severable.

23

24 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
25 hereby repealed.

26

27 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
28 General Assembly that due to an increased workload in the Fourth Judicial
29 District and the financial pressures of inflation that the compensation now
30 provided for the secretary-court reporter-case coordinators of the Fourth
31 Judicial District is inadequate. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
32 to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
33 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
34 after its passage and approval.
