SENATE BILL 235

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE THE BORROWING OR ARRANGING OF FUNDS BY A
9 LICENSEE FROM A CONSUMER NOT IN THE ORDINARY COURSE OF
10 BUSINESS OF MAKING LOANS A DEFINED UNFAIR METHOD OF
11 COMPETITION AND UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE ACT OR PRACTICE; AND
12 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "TO MAKE IT A TRADE PRACTICE VIOLATION
16 FOR A LICENSEE TO BORROW OR ARRANGE FOR
17 FUNDS FROM A CONSUMER NOT IN THE
18 ORDINARY COURSE OF BUSINESS OF MAKING
19 LOANS."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-66-206 is hereby amended by adding a new
24 subsection (13) at the end of the existing section to read as follows:

25 "(13) Borrowing from Consumers is wherein the licensee borrows or
26 arranges for funds from his consumer who is not in the ordinary course of
27 business of making loans."

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 23-64-218 is hereby amended by revising
30 subsection (a)(4) to read as follows:

31 "(a)(4) Misappropriation or conversion to his own use or illegal
32 withholding of moneys belonging to policyholders, insurers, beneficiaries, or
33 others and received in conduct of business under the license; including the
34 obtaining or arranging of loans from any of his consumers when that consumer
35 is not in the ordinary course of business of making loans;"

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
