## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO CORRECT AND CLARIFY ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §  
9 14-142-208 PERTAINING TO LIBRARY BONDS; AND FOR OTHER  
10 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "PERTAINING TO LIBRARY BONDS."

14

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-142-208(a) is amended to read  
18 as follows:

19 "(a) The question of the issuance of such bonds shall be submitted to  
20 the electors of the municipality or county at the general election or at a  
21 special election called for that purpose as provided in the ordinance or  
22 order and held in the manner provided in this subchapter; provided, however,  
23 that no voter residing within a municipality levying a maintenance tax for  
24 libraries or levying a tax pledged for the purpose of retiring library bonds  
25 issued by the municipality or pledged to pay for capital improvements to or  
26 construction of a public library pursuant to Arkansas Constitution, Amendment  
27 30 and Amendment 72, shall be entitled to vote on the question of the  
28 issuance of bonds by the county within which the municipality is located as  
29 authorized pursuant to Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 38, Amendment 72 and  
30 this act."

31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
33 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
34 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1           SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
5 act are declared to be severable.

7           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
8 hereby repealed.
