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## 7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS FOR STATE  
9 OWNED LANDS, HISTORIC PRESERVATION AND MAIN STREET  
10 ARKANSAS PROGRAMS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS HERITAGE  
11 - NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL WHICH SHALL BE  
12 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED  
13 BY ACT 730 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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## 15 Subtitle

16 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
17 HERITAGE - NATURAL AND CULTURAL  
18 RESOURCES COUNCIL SUPPLEMENTAL  
19 APPROPRIATION."

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - STATE OWNED LANDS/HISTORIC SITES. There  
24 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural and  
25 Cultural Resources Council, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and  
26 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for grants for the acquisition,  
27 management, stewardship and preservation of state owned lands or historic  
28 sites which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated  
29 in Section 52 of Act 730 of 1993, the following:

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1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - MAIN STREET PROGRAM. There is hereby  
2 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural and Cultural  
3 Resources Council, to be payable from the Natural and Cultural Resources  
4 Historic Preservation Fund, for grants for the Historic Preservation and Main  
5 Street Arkansas Programs which shall be supplemental and in addition to those  
6 funds appropriated in Section 53 of Act 730 of 1993, the following:

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12 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
13 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
15 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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22 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
24 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
25 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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31 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
32 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
33 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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35 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

1 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
2 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
3 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
4 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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6 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
7 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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9 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
10 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for  
11 the operations of the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural and Cultural  
12 Resources Council are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the  
13 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council to  
14 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of  
15 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Arkansas  
16 Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council to continue such services;  
17 and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable  
18 harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
19 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
20 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
21 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
22 passage and approval.

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
