## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR DISBURSEMENTS TO THE  
 9 RURAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL AND THE UNITED STATES OLYMPIC  
 10 COMMITTEE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION  
 11 - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE  
 12 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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## Subtitle

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"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE  
 AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER  
 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - RURAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL. There is hereby  
 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing  
 Officer, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief  
 Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses of the Arkansas Rural  
 Development Council for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the  
 following:

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4 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - U.S. OLYMPIC COMMITTEE. There is hereby  
 5 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing  
 6 Officer, to be payable from the United State Olympic Committee Program Trust  
 7 Fund as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for payments to  
 8 the United States Olympic Committee of funds collected under the provisions  
 9 of Arkansas Code §26-51-441 for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the  
 10 following:

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16 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 17 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 19 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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26 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 28 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 29 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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35 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and

1 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
2 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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4       SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
5 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
6 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
7 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
8 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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10       SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
11 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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13       SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
14 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
15 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;  
16 that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the  
17 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are  
18 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the  
19 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work  
20 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
21 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
22 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
23 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after  
24 July 1, 1995.

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
