For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 16-46-101 TO AUTHORIZE
8 COUNTY RECORDERS, COURT CLERKS, AND OTHER PUBLIC OFFICERS
9 TO DESTROY ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS ONCE RECORDED BY
10 PHOTOGRAPHIC, PHOTOSTATIC, MICROFILM, MICROCARD, OPTICAL
11 DISC OR OTHER PROCESS WHICH ACCURATELY FORMS A DURABLE
12 MEDIUM FOR REPRODUCING THE ORIGINAL; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES."

16 "TO AUTHORIZE COUNTY RECORDERS, COURT
17 CLERKS, AND OTHER PUBLIC OFFICERS TO
18 DESTROY ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS ONCE RECORDED
19 BY A PROCESS WHICH FORMS A DURABLE
20 MEDIUM FOR REPRODUCING THE ORIGINAL."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-46-101(a)(2) is amended to read as
26 follows:

27 "(2) The county recorders, clerks of courts of record, and any public
28 officer whose duty it is to make public records are authorized to use and
29 employ an approved system of photographic recording, photostatic recording,
30 microfilm, microcard, miniature photographic recording, optical disc, or
31 other process which accurately reproduces or forms a durable medium for
32 reproducing the original when provided with equipment necessary for such
33 method of recording. When any document is recorded by the means prescribed
34 by this subdivision, the original may be destroyed unless its preservation is
35 required by law."

2 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
3 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
4 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5

6 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
7 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
8 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
9 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10 act are declared to be severable.

12 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13 hereby repealed.
