18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
21 Arkansas State University for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum  
22 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
23 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
24 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
25 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
26 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
27 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
28 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
29 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
30 or its successor.

26 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the  
27 Arkansas State University for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum  
28 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
29 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: eight hundred  
30 fifty six (856) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of  
31 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
32 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
33 classification.

34

35 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL REVENUE. There is hereby

1 appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the  
2 Arkansas State University Fund, for personal services and operating expenses  
3 of the Arkansas State University for the biennial period ending June 30,  
4 1997, the following:

28 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
29 to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
30 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas State University, for personal  
31 services and operating expenses of the Arkansas State University for the

28 SECTION 5. SPECIAL ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary  
29 allowances for housing and other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of  
30 the athletic director, assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and  
31 assistant coaches at Arkansas State University, the Board of Trustees may  
32 make special allowances available therefor in such amounts as the Board of  
33 Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the  
34 unusual and exacting duties of said athletic director, assistant athletic  
35 directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the purpose of

1 providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from  
2 the auxiliary income of the Arkansas State University, which is derived from  
3 athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed twenty thousand dollars  
4 (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each year of the 1995-97  
5 biennium for the athletic director and head coaches, and ten thousand dollars  
6 (\$10,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during the 1995-97 biennium for  
7 the assistant athletic directors and assistant coaches. Provided that any  
8 such allowances shall be in addition to the regular salary of such athletic  
9 director, assistant athletic directors, head coaches and assistant coaches,  
10 as established herein provided that the amount of such allowance shall not  
11 exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum for any one salaried  
12 position. Further, Arkansas State University shall report annually to the  
13 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of the special  
14 allowance funds authorized herein.

15

16       *SECTION 6. Upon determination by the President of Arkansas State*  
17 *University that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or*  
18 *consolidation of administrative functions within the university is necessary*  
19 *for efficient and effective operations of the university, the president, with*  
20 *approval of the Arkansas State University Board of Trustees, may have the*  
21 *authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between*  
22 *campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of Arkansas State*  
23 *University. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be*  
24 *used for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the*  
25 *General Assembly. The transfers, consolidation, or reorganization which*  
26 *involve academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher*  
27 *Education and the Legislative Council.*

28

29       *SECTION 7. HOUSING ALLOWANCE. Upon approval by the Arkansas State*  
30 *University Board of Trustees, the Chancellor or Director, if there is no*  
31 *Chancellor, of the various branch campuses of Arkansas State University may*  
32 *receive a housing allowance in an amount not to exceed four hundred dollars*  
33 *(\$400) per month in lieu of college housing.*

34

35       SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
3 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure  
6 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
7 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
8 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
9 with in disbursement of said funds.

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11       SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
13 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
14 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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20       SECTION 10. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
21 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
22 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

23

24       SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
25 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
26 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
27 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
28 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

29

30       SECTION 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
31 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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33       SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by  
34 the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
35 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year

1 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to  
2 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are  
3 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the  
4 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work  
5 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
6 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
7 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
8 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after  
9 July 1, 1995.
