14 "AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS
15 AT LITTLE ROCK APPROPRIATION FOR THE
16 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
21 University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the 1995-97 biennium, the following
22 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
23 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
24 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
25 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
26 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
27 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
28 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
29 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
30 or its successor.

20 thousand two hundred seventy five (1,275) temporary or part-time employees,
21 ~~when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform~~
22 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
23 appropriate classification.

25 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL REVENUE. There is hereby
26 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, to be payable
27 from the University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund, for personal services
28 and operating expenses of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the
29 biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

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8 SECTION 5. SPECIAL ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary
9 allowances for housing and other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of
10 the athletic director, assistant athletic director, head basketball coach,
11 and assistant coaches at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the Board
12 of Trustees may make special allowances available therefor in such amounts as
13 the Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in
14 view of the unusual and exacting duties of said athletic director, assistant
15 athletic director, head basketball coach, and assistant coaches, and for the
16 purpose of providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to
17 expend from the auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas at Little
18 Rock, which is derived from athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed
19 twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during
20 each year of the 1995-97 biennium for the athletic director and head
21 basketball coach, and ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the aggregate for
22 such purposes during the 1995-97 biennium for the assistant athletic director
23 and assistant coaches. Provided that any such allowances shall be in addition
24 to the regular salary of such athletic director, assistant athletic director,
25 head basketball coach and assistant coaches, as established herein provided
26 that the amount of such allowance shall not exceed ten thousand dollars
27 (\$10,000) per annum for any one salaried position. Further, the University
28 of Arkansas at Little Rock shall report annually to the Legislative Joint
29 Auditing Committee the exact disposition of the special allowance funds
30 authorized herein.

31

32 SECTION 6. *None of the positions authorized or funds appropriated*
33 *herein shall be used for the support of the Science Information Liaison*
34 *Office (SILO) program, or its successor program or programs. All assets*
35 *allocated to the SILO program shall be transferred to the Bureau of*

1 *Legislative Research, to be used for research and constituency services for*
2 *the 135 members of the Arkansas General Assembly.*

3

4 *SECTION 7. On July 1 of each fiscal year of the 1995-97 biennium, the*
5 *Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer the sum of \$171,113 from the*
6 *University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund to the State Central Services Fund*
7 *as a direct revenue, there to be used exclusively for the House and Senate*
8 *Offices of Constituency Services.*

9

10 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure
16 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
17 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
18 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
19 with in disbursement of said funds.

20

21 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
23 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
24 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 SECTION 10. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
31 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
32 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

34 SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
35 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

1 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
2 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
3 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

4

5 SECTION 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
6 with this Act are hereby repealed.

7

8 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
9 the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
10 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
11 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to
12 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
13 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
14 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
15 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
16 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
17 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
18 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
19 July 1, 1995.
