## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-3-215 TO EXTEND THE  
8 PERIOD OF TIME A STATE EMPLOYEE MAY CONVERT FROM THE  
9 CONTRIBUTORY PERS PLAN TO THE NONCONTRIBUTORY PERS PLAN;  
10 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

12 "TO EXTEND THE PERIOD OF TIME A STATE  
13 EMPLOYEE MAY CONVERT FROM THE  
14 CONTRIBUTORY PERS PLAN TO THE NON-  
15 CONTRIBUTORY PERS PLAN."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-3-215 is amended to read as follows:  
20 "24-3-215. Conversion from contributory to noncontributory plan -  
21 Extension of time.

22 Any person who, under §§ 24-3-102, 24-3-201 - 24-3-214, 24-3-301,  
23 24-3-302, or any other act, was authorized to convert from the contributory  
24 plan of the Arkansas Public Employees\_ Retirement System to the  
25 noncontributory plan of the Arkansas Public Employees\_ Retirement System  
26 prior to January 1, 1985, may convert from the contributory plan to the  
27 noncontributory plan at any time prior to June 30, 1996, in the manner  
28 prescribed by law for conversion before January 1, 1985."

29

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
31 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
32 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

1        SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
5 act are declared to be severable.

6

7        SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
8 hereby repealed.

9

10       SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the  
11 General Assembly that those state employees who still participate in the  
12 contributory plan under the Public Employees Retirement System should be  
13 allowed to convert to the noncontributory plan; that this act so provides;  
14 and that this act should go into effect immediately in order to provide this  
15 option to those state employees as soon as possible. Therefore, an emergency  
16 is hereby declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the  
17 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force  
18 and effect from and after its passage and approval.
