18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
21 University of Arkansas, its various divisions and the Archeological Survey
22 for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
23 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
24 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
25 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
26 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
27 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 7. REFUND TO EXPENDITURES. Proceeds derived from the maturity or redemptions of investments as authorized in Section 6 of this Act for the University of Arkansas Soils Testing and Research Program shall be deemed "Refunds to Expenditures" for all monies invested.

1

2 SECTION 8. GRANTS AND CONTRACTS. The Arkansas Archeological Survey is
3 authorized to enter into contracts with and to receive and expend gifts,
4 grants, or other funds from federal, private, or other sources to be used in
5 furtherance of the program of the Survey within the limitations of the
6 maximum annual salary rates as set forth in this Act.

7

8 SECTION 9. USE AND DISBURSING OFFICER. The funds appropriated under
9 Section 3 and allocated in Item (5) of Section 4 of this Act are to be used
10 for the personal services and maintenance and general operation of the
11 Arkansas Archeological Survey and for no other purpose. The Vice-President
12 for Finance and Administration of the University of Arkansas is hereby made
13 the disbursing officer for the appropriation made by this Act.

14

15 SECTION 10. SPECIAL ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing
16 necessary allowances for housing and other unusual expenses incurred by or on
17 behalf of the athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors,
18 head coaches and assistant coaches in the men's and women's Athletic
19 Departments at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, the Board of
20 Trustees may make special allowances available therefor in such amounts as
21 the Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in
22 view of the unusual and exacting duties of said athletic directors, associate
23 and assistant athletic directors, head coaches and assistant coaches, and for
24 the purpose of providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized
25 to expend from the auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas,
26 Fayetteville, which is derived from athletic event receipts, or from
27 contributions from sources other than state funds, an amount not to exceed
28 ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each for such purposes during each year of the
29 1995-97 biennium for the athletic directors, associate athletic directors,
30 and head coaches, and an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000)
31 each for the assistant athletic directors and assistant coaches. Any such
32 allowances shall be in addition to the regular salary of such athletic
33 directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches and
34 assistant coaches. Further, the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville shall
35 report annually to the Arkansas Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the

1 exact disposition of the special allowance funds authorized herein.

2 In recognition of the extra work involved in the participation of
3 intercollegiate athletic teams in post-season competition, and to promote
4 exceptional achievement in the total sports program, the Chancellor of the
5 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, in accordance with policies issued by
6 the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas, may approve additional
7 compensation of up to one month's salary for the Athletic Department and Band
8 personnel when any athletic team participates in post-season competition or
9 achieves exceptional recognition, which shall be in addition to the regular
10 salaries authorized by law, provided that the additional compensation shall
11 be paid from contributions from sources other than public funds.

12

13 *SECTION 11. None of the positions authorized or funds appropriated*
14 *herein shall be used for the support of the Science Information Liaison*
15 *Office (SILO) program, the Community Assistance Program, or their successor*
16 *programs. All assets and funds allocated to the SILO program shall be*
17 *transferred to the Bureau of Legislative Research, to be used for research*
18 *and constituency services for the 135 members of the Arkansas General*
19 *Assembly.*

20

21 *SECTION 12. On July 1 of each fiscal year of the 1995-97 biennium, the*
22 *Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer the sum of \$93,365 from the*
23 *University of Arkansas Fund to the State Central Services Fund as a direct*
24 *revenue, there to be used exclusively for the House and Senate Offices of*
25 *Constituency Services.*

26

27 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
28 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
30 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure
33 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
34 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
35 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

1 with in disbursement of said funds.

2

3 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
4 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
5 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
6 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
7 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
8 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
9 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
10 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

11

12 SECTION 15. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
13 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
14 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

15

16 SECTION 16. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
17 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
18 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
19 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
20 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

21

22 SECTION 17. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
23 with this Act are hereby repealed.

24

25 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
26 the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
27 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
28 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to
29 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
30 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
31 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
32 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
33 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
34 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
35 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after

1 July 1, 1995.
