SENATE BILL 452

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §§ 12-63-406 AND
9 3-4-703 TO AUTHORIZE PURCHASES AT THE CAMP JOSEPH T.
10 ROBINSON CANTEEN BY CERTAIN PERSONS ATTENDING VARIOUS
11 TRAINING PROGRAMS AND PERFORMING WORK AT CAMP JOSEPH T.
12 ROBINSON; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "TO AUTHORIZE PURCHASES AT THE CAMP
16 JOSEPH T. ROBINSON CANTEEN BY CERTAIN
17 PERSONS ATTENDING VARIOUS TRAINING
18 PROGRAMS AND PERFORMING WORK AT CAMP
19 JOSEPH T. ROBINSON"

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 12-63-406 is amended to read as
24 follows:

25 "12-63-406. Canteen - Inventory and sales - Tax exemption.

26 (a) The Adjutant General, acting for and on behalf of the Arkansas
27 National Guard, shall have authority to purchase normally regarded canteen
28 inventory items, subject to the limitations prescribed in § 12-63-404.

29 (b) The sale of all these items shall be made only to active and
30 retired members of the Army and Air National Guard of the United States; to
31 active, retired, and reserve members of the armed forces of the United
32 States; to Department of Defense employees ; to full-time employees of the
33 Arkansas Military Department; and to dependents of the above-named persons
34 who hold proper identification cards. Sales may also be made to students
35 attending training programs at Camp J. T. Robinson; and to contractors

1 performing work under contract with the United States or State of Arkansas at
2 Camp J. T. Robinson;

3 (c) The items shall be exempt from the imposition of any taxes levied
4 by the State of Arkansas or by any subdivision thereof."

6 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated § 3-4-703 is amended to read as
7 follows:

8 "3-4-703. Authorized purchasers.

9 Sales of alcoholic beverages under the post exchange package permit
10 shall be limited to those persons over the age of twenty-one (21) years, who
11 are members of the Army and Air National Guard of the United States; to
12 active, retired, and reserve members of the armed forces of the United
13 States; to Department of Defense employees; to full-time employees of the
14 Arkansas Military Department; and to dependents of the above-named persons
15 who hold proper identification cards. Sales may also be made to students
16 attending training programs at Camp J. T. Robinson; and to contractors
17 performing work under contract with the United States or State of Arkansas at
18 Camp J. T. Robinson."

20 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
21 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
22 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

23

24 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
25 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
26 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
27 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
28 act are declared to be severable.

30 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
31 hereby repealed.
