# A Bill

SENATE BILL

465

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## 7                   For An Act To Be Entitled

8                   "AN ACT TO AMEND VARIOUS SECTIONS OF TITLE 24, CHAPTER 3,  
9                   OF THE ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987, ANNOTATED, TO REDUCE THE  
10                  MINIMUM SERVICE TIME TO FIVE (5) YEARS FOR MEMBERS, *EXCEPT*  
11                  *MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY*, TO VEST UNDER THE PUBLIC  
12                  EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1996; AND  
13                  FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

16                   "AN ACT TO REDUCE THE MINIMUM SERVICE TO  
17                  FIVE (5) YEARS FOR MEMBERS, *EXCEPT*  
18                  *MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY*, TO VEST  
19                  IN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT  
20                  SYSTEM."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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24                  SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-3-201(a) is amended to read as follows:  
25                  "(a)(1) Any member in named plan employment may retire with an annuity  
26 provided for in subsection (e) of this section upon his written application  
27 to the governing body of his named plan setting forth at what time, not less  
28 than thirty (30) days nor more than ninety (90) days subsequent to the  
29 execution and filing of his application, he desires to be retired.

30                  (2) At the time of his separation from employment and at the  
31 time so specified for his retirement, the member must have attained normal  
32 retirement age and must have five (5) or more years of credited service,  
33 *except for members of the General Assembly who must have ten (10) or more*  
34 *years of credited service.*

35                  (3) The member's annuity starting date shall be that date

1 established by the provisions in each named plan, and he shall have a right  
2 to elect an option provided for in § 24-3-203."

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4 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-3-206(a)(1) is amended to read as  
5 follows:

6 "(1) *Except for members of the General Assembly who must have at least*  
7 *ten (10) years of credited service, the member has five (5) or more years of*  
8 *total credited service with named plans or with reciprocal systems under the*  
9 *provisions of §§ 24-2-401 - 24-2-405 if, in establishing the minimum total*  
10 *credited service, periods of credited service covering the same calendar time*  
11 *shall be counted only once. However, both service in the Arkansas Public*  
12 *Employees' Retirement System as a member of the General Assembly and service*  
13 *in another reciprocal system during the same period of time may be counted to*  
14 *meet the service requirements for benefits from the reciprocal systems,*  
15 *subject to the following:*

16 (A) The provisions of § 24-3-301 may not be used to meet the  
17 service requirements;

18 (B) The benefit payable by a reciprocal system will be based on  
19 the credited service in that system and on the final average pay under that  
20 system; and

21 (C) If a member has fewer than five (5) actual years of service  
22 credited in a reciprocal system, then final average pay means the monthly  
23 average of pay to him during his total years of service in that system;"

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25 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-3-207 is amended to read as follows:

26 "24-3-207. Benefit provisions - Early retirement.

27 (a)(1) Any member or former member with sufficient years of credited  
28 service to qualify for a vested termination annuity who has not attained his  
29 normal retirement age may retire with an early annuity provided for in  
30 subsection (b) of this section upon his written application to the plan  
31 setting forth at what time, not less than thirty (30) days nor more than  
32 ninety (90) days subsequent to the execution and filing of his application,  
33 he desires to be retired.

34 (2) The member or former member eligible for a vested  
35 termination annuity must have at least five (5) years of credited service and

1 be within ten (10) years of normal retirement age, except for members of the  
2 General Assembly who must have at least ten (10) years of credited service  
3 and be within ten (10) years of normal retirement age.

4       (b) Upon early retirement, a member shall receive a certain percent of  
5 an annuity for life provided for in § 24-3-201(e), which percent shall be one  
6 hundred percent (100%) reduced by one-half of one percent (0.5%) multiplied  
7 by the number of months by which his age at early retirement is younger than  
8 his normal retirement age, using what his normal retirement age would have  
9 been if he had continued named plan-covered employment from the time of early  
10 retirement."

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12       SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-3-208(a) is amended to read as follows:

13       "(a)(1) Except for members of the General Assembly who need at least  
14 ten (10) years of credited service, any active member with five (5) or more  
15 years of credited service, including credited service for at least eighteen  
16 (18) of the twenty-four (24) calendar months immediately preceding his  
17 disability, who becomes totally and permanently physically or mentally  
18 incapacitated for any suitable job or position as an employee, as a result of  
19 a personal injury or disease may be retired by the board of trustees upon  
20 written application filed with the board by or on behalf of the member. This  
21 may take place only if, after a medical examination of the member made by or  
22 under the direction of a physician or physicians designated by the board, the  
23 physician reports to the board in writing that the member is physically or  
24 mentally totally incapacitated for any suitable job or position, that the  
25 incapacity will probably be permanent, and that the member should be retired.

26       (2) The disability annuity shall be effective the first day of  
27 the calendar month next following the later of either his termination of  
28 active membership or thirty (30) days after the date the written application  
29 is filed with the board."

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31       SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 24-3-301 is hereby amended to read as  
32 follows:

33       "24-3-301. Credited service generally.

34       (a) The governing body of each named plan shall establish the amounts  
35 of service to be credited its members subject to the provisions of subsection

1 (b) of this section.

2       (b)(1) Employment as a public safety member shall be credited at one  
3 and one-half (1 1/2) times the regular rate for crediting service, except  
4 that at least five (5) years of actual service shall be required to meet the  
5 retirement eligibility requirements of §§ 24-3-201(a) and (b), 24-3-206(a),  
6 24-3-207(a), and 24-3-208, and at least five (5) years of actual service  
7 shall be required to meet the eligibility requirements of § 24-3-209.

8           (2) Employment as Governor shall be credited as service at three  
9 (3) times the regular rate for credited service, except that at least four  
10 (4) years of actual service shall be required to meet the retirement  
11 eligibility requirements of §§ 24-3-201(a) and (b), 24-3-206(a), 24-3-207(a),  
12 and 24-3-208, and at least five (5) years of actual service shall be required  
13 to meet the eligibility requirements of § 24-3-209.

14           (3)(A)(i) Employment as an elected state constitutional officer  
15 shall be credited at two and one-half (2 1/2) times the regular rate for  
16 crediting service, except that at least five (5) years of actual service  
17 shall be required to meet the retirement eligibility requirements of §§  
18 24-3-201(a) and (b), 24-3-206(a), 24-3-207(a), and 24-3-208, and at least  
19 five (5) years of actual service shall be required to meet eligibility  
20 requirements of § 24-3-209.

21           (ii) *Employment as a member of the General Assembly shall be*  
22 *credited at the regular rate for crediting service, except that at least ten*  
23 *(10) years of actual service shall be required to meet the retirement*  
24 *eligibility requirements of §§ 24-3-201(a) and (b), 24-3-206(a), 24-3-207(a),*  
25 *and 24-3-208, and at least five (5) years of actual service shall be required*  
26 *to meet eligibility requirements of § 24-3-209.*

27           (B) A member of the General Assembly who at any time has  
28 served at least six (6) months during a two-year term to the General Assembly  
29 shall be credited with no more than one (1) year actual service.

30           (4) Employment as an elected public official other than Governor  
31 or an elected state constitutional officer *or a member of the General*  
32 *Assembly shall be credited as service at two (2) times the regular rate for*  
33 *crediting service, except that at least five (5) years of actual service*  
34 *shall be required to meet the retirement eligibility requirements of §§*  
35 *24-3-201(a) and (b), 24-3-206(a), 24-3-207(a), and 24-3-208, and at least*

1 five (5) years of actual service shall be required to meet the eligibility  
2 requirements of § 24-3-209.

3                 (5) As used in this section, elected state constitutional  
4 officer means the Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State,  
5 State Auditor, State Treasurer, and Commissioner of State Lands."

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7                 SECTION 6. The provisions of this act shall be effective *July 1, 1997*.

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9                 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature  
10 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
11 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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13                 SECTION 8. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to  
14 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect  
15 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
16 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
17 act are declared to be severable.

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19                 SECTION 9. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
20 hereby repealed.
