18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 21-5-106(c) is hereby amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "(c) An employee who meets eligibility requirements established by
23 subsection (a) of this section shall become eligible for annual career
24 service recognition payments on the anniversary date of the completion of
25 such service according to the following schedule:

SECTION 2. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
2 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
3 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
4 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
5 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

7 SECTION 4. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
8 with this Act are hereby repealed.

9

10 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
11 Eightieth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas meeting in Regular
12 Session, that the awarding of annual career service recognition payments to
13 career State employees is necessary to promote morale and retention of vital
14 career employees in State service. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
15 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
16 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
17 after July 1, 1995.
