7 "AN ACT TO ADJUST THE SALARIES AND TO MAKE AN  
8 APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES WHICH SHALL BE  
9 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED  
10 BY ACT 3 OF 1995 FOR THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OF  
11 GOVERNMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH AMENDMENT 70 OF THE ARKANSAS  
12 CONSTITUTION."

## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO ADJUST THE SALARIES AND TO  
16 APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EXECUTIVE

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. The salaries of the following elected officials shall be as  
23 follows:

35 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to be

1 payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for salaries of the various  
2 Constitutional Officers which shall be supplemental and in addition to those  
3 funds appropriated in Items (1) through (7) of Section 1 of Act 3 of 1995,  
4 for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

10 SECTION 3. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
11 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
12 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13

14 SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
15 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
16 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
17 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
18 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

19

20 SECTION 5. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
21 with this Act are hereby repealed.

22

23 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
24 Eightieth General Assembly, that Amendment 70 of the Constitution of Arkansas  
25 provides that salaries of the Executive Department officials may be increased  
26 annually by an amount not to exceed the average percentage increase in the  
27 Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers or its successor, as published  
28 by the United States Department of Labor, for the two years immediately  
29 preceding the year of the salary appropriation; that this act establishes the  
30 proper salaries for the Executive Department; that the delay in the effective  
31 date of this act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration  
32 and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is  
33 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate  
34 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force  
35 and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
