SENATE BILL 523

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## 7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE ACTIVE AND RETIRED CERTIFIED LAW  
9 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO CARRY CONCEALED HANDGUNS; AND FOR  
10 OTHER PURPOSES."

### 12 Subtitle

13 "TO AUTHORIZE ACTIVE AND RETIRED  
14 CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO  
15 CARRY CONCEALED HANDGUNS"

16

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. (a) Any certified law enforcement officer:

20 (1) who is presently in the employ of a public law enforcement  
21 department, office or agency; and  
22 (2) who is authorized by the public law enforcement department,  
23 office or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her  
24 duties; and

25 (3) who is not subject to any disciplinary action by the public  
26 law enforcement department, office or agency; and

27 (4) who is carrying appropriate written identification issued by  
28 the public law enforcement department, office or agency identifying him or  
29 her as a certified law enforcement officer; and

30 (5) who is not otherwise prohibited under state or federal law;  
31 may carry a concealed handgun.

32 (b) Any retired law enforcement officer:

33 (1) who retired from service with a public law enforcement  
34 department, office or agency for reasons other than mental disability; and  
35 (2) who immediately before retirement was a certified law

1 enforcement officer authorized by the public law enforcement department,  
2 office or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her  
3 duties; and

4                   (3) who has nonforfeitable rights to benefits under the  
5 retirement plan of the public law enforcement department, office or agency;  
6 and

7                   (4) who is carrying appropriate written identification issued by  
8 the public law enforcement department, office or agency identifying him or  
9 her as a retired and former certified law enforcement officer; and

10                  (5) *who is not otherwise prohibited under state or federal law;*  
11 *and,*

12                  *(6) who has written authorization from the chief law enforcement  
13 officer of the city or county in which he resides; may carry a concealed  
14 handgun in accordance with regulations prescribed by the board created by  
15 this act. The chief law enforcement officer of the city or county shall keep  
16 a record of all retired law enforcement officers authorized to carry a  
17 concealed handgun in his jurisdiction and shall revoke any authorization for  
18 good cause shown.*

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20                  SECTION 2. For purposes of this act, the term:

21                  (a) "Certified law enforcement officer" means any appointed or elected  
22 law enforcement officer or sheriff employed by a public law enforcement  
23 department, office or agency who works forty (40) or more hours per week and  
24 who is responsible for the prevention and detection of crime and the  
25 enforcement of the criminal, traffic, or highway laws of this state and who  
26 has met the selection and training requirements for certification set by the  
27 Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training.

28                  (b) "Public law enforcement department, office or agency" means any  
29 public police department, sheriff's office, or other public agency, force or  
30 organization whose primary responsibility as established by law, statute or  
31 ordinance is the enforcement of the criminal, traffic, or highway laws of  
32 this state.

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34                  SECTION 3. (a) *There is hereby created a board to be composed of four  
35 (4) persons appointed by the Governor. One (1) person shall be appointed*

1 from a list of names provided by the Arkansas Municipal Police Association,  
2 one (1) person shall be appointed from a list of names provided by the  
3 Arkansas Police Chiefs Association, one (1) person shall be appointed from a  
4 list of names provided by the Arkansas Sheriffs Association and one (1)  
5 person shall be appointed from a list of names provided by the Arkansas State  
6 Police Association. Appointees shall serve two (2) year terms.

7       (b) The board shall promulgate regulations which prescribe  
8 restrictions under which retired law enforcement officers may carry concealed  
9 weapons and the regulation shall also prescribe the procedure for the conduct  
10 of a thorough background check for the retired law enforcement officers and  
11 only those retired law enforcement officers whose background check is  
12 acceptable to the board shall be entitled to carry a concealed weapon under  
13 this act.

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15       SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
16 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
17 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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19       SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
20 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
21 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
23 act are declared to be severable.

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25       SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
26 hereby repealed.
