SENATE BILL 534

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 10-3-301 (a) CONCERNING
9 SERVICE ON THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL BY THE IMMEDIATE PAST
10 PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE OR THE NEXT PRECEDING
11 PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

16 "AN ACT CONCERNING SERVICE ON THE
17 LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL BY THE IMMEDIATE
18 PAST PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE
19 OR THE NEXT PRECEDING PRESIDENT PRO
20 TEMPORE OF THE SENATE."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 10-3-301 (a) is amended to read as follows:

26 "(a) An ad interim committee of the General Assembly is hereby
27 established as a Legislative Council, which shall consist of thirty-six (36)
28 members to be selected as follows:

29 (1) The Senate of the General Assembly shall select sometime
30 before adjournment of each regular session twelve (12) members, with three
31 (3) members to be chosen from each of the four (4) congressional districts of
32 the state in effect on January 1, 1987, by caucus of the members of the
33 Senate residing in their respective congressional districts;

34 (2) The House of Representatives of the General Assembly shall
35 select twenty (20) members in accordance with the procedure prescribed by

1 House Rules;

2 (3) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the immediate past
3 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
4 Representatives, the immediate past Speaker of the House of Representatives,
5 and the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Legislative Joint Auditing
6 Committee shall be ex officio members of the Legislative Council and shall
7 enjoy the same rights and privileges as other council members. If the
8 immediate past President Pro Tempore of the Senate is no longer a member of
9 the Senate, then the next preceding President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall
10 be an ex officio member of the Legislative Council and shall enjoy the same
11 rights and privileges as other council members."
12

13 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
14 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
15 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
16

17 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
21 act are declared to be severable.

23 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
24 hereby repealed.
