9 SOCIAL WORKERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

"TO AMEND § 17-39-205 AND § 17-39-303
RELATING TO SOCIAL WORKERS."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-39-205 is amended to read as follows:
18 "17-39-205. Fees.

19 The board shall establish, charge, and collect for:

20 (1) The filing of an application for a license under this chapter, a
21 fee of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00);

22 (2) The taking of an examination, a fee as established by regulation
23 of the board;

24 (3) The original issuance of a license under this chapter, a fee of
25 not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00);

26 (4) A renewal of a license issued in accordance with this chapter, a
27 fee of not more than forty dollars (\$40.00);

28 (5) Replacement of a license or renewal lost or destroyed, a fee of
29 not less than ten dollars (\$10.00); and

30 (6) Endorsement of a foreign license, a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00)."

31

32 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-39-303 is amended to read as follows:
33 "17-39-303. Temporary licenses.

34 (a) A social worker who comes to reside in Arkansas and does not
35 qualify for licensing under § 17-39-302, but who is otherwise qualified for

1 licensing, may be issued a temporary license by the board at the appropriate
2 level for the practice of social work for a period of up to six (6) months
3 until the board conducts its regular licensing examinations.

4 (b) An individual who resides in Arkansas and completes the
5 educational requirements for licensing as a licensed social worker or
6 licensed master social worker under § 17-39-306 may be issued a temporary
7 license by the board at the appropriate level for the practice of social work
8 for a period of up to six (6) months until the board conducts its regular
9 licensing examinations."

10

11 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
12 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
13 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

14

15 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
16 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
17 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
19 act are declared to be severable.

20

21 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
22 hereby repealed.
