## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE EIGHTIETH SESSION PROJECTS  
9 ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND; TO DEFINE THE  
10 MONIES TO BE AVAILABLE IN SUCH ACCOUNT; AND TO DEFINE THE  
11 PURPOSES FOR WHICH MONIES MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE FROM THE  
12 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21

22 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the "General Improvment  
23 Distribution Act of 1995".

24

25 SECTION 2. There is hereby created and established on the books of the  
26 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Treasurer and the State Auditor,  
27 the "80th Session Projects Account" within the "General Improvement Fund",  
28 into which shall be transferred and credited the respective monies as  
29 hereinafter provided in this Act, to be used for providing financing, in the  
30 manner set forth herein, for the various projects and purposes enumerated in  
31 this Act to be financed from said account.

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Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, or as soon thereafter  
as is practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer and credit to the "80th  
Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund", upon  
certification of the amounts thereof by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the

1 State, the following:

2 (a) all unobligated and unallocated monies remaining in the "General  
3 Improvement Fund" which are not required to finance projects to be financed  
4 therefrom pursuant to appropriations enacted by the 79th General Assembly, or  
5 which have not been reappropriated or reallocated for financing from the  
6 "General Improvement Fund" by the 80th General Assembly;

7 (b) any unobligated or unallocated funds remaining in the "General  
8 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund" from monies accruing thereto during the 1993-  
9 95 fiscal biennium which are not required to finance enactments of the 80th  
10 General Assembly that do not expire on June 30, 1995;

11 (c) funds available in the Future Operations Reserve Fund as  
12 authorized by law, and;

13 (d) interest earned on State Treasury fund balances as provided in  
14 this subsection. For the period commencing on July 1, 1995 and ending June  
15 30, 1997, the State Treasurer shall, after complying with provisions of

16 (1) Arkansas Code §27-70-204 for distributing interest income  
17 earned from investment of average daily balances of the "State Highway and  
18 Transportation Department Fund",

19 (2) Arkansas Code §15-41-110 for distributing interest earned  
20 from investment of average daily balances of the "Game Protection Fund",

21 (3) Arkansas Code §15-5-422 for the first two million dollars  
22 (\$2,000,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State  
23 Treasurer as authorized for the Correction Facilities Construction Fund, and

24 (4) Arkansas Code §20-78-504 for the next one hundred thousand  
25 dollars (\$100,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State  
26 Treasurer for the Arkansas Child Care Facilities Loan Guarantee Trust Fund,  
27 credit to the "Budget Stabilization Trust Fund" or its successor fund, fifty  
28 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities  
29 Reserve Fund", and credit to the "80th Session Projects Account" fifty  
30 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities  
31 Reserve Fund" as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to  
32 provide financing to the "80th Session Projects Account," until there has  
33 been credited an amount, which when added to the other funds available for  
34 such purposes will finance each of the projects or purposes hereinafter  
35 enumerated.

2 SECTION 3. (A) From the monies accruing to the benefit of the "80th  
3 Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund" as authorized by  
4 Section 2 of this Act, the Governor may direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of  
5 the State to effectuate an allocation of monies for financing certain  
6 appropriation and transfers of monies as authorized by the 80th General  
7 Assembly as follows:

30 or projects listed in subsection (A) of this section cannot be made due to  
31 the inadequacy of required matching monies, the Governor is hereby authorized  
32 to defer to a later time such allocations and then proceed to authorize  
33 allocations of monies in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (B) of  
34 this Section. Such allocations of monies previously deferred, may be  
35 authorized by the Governor at any time after complying with the matching

1 requirements.

2 (B) After financing is provided for the purposes and projects  
3 enumerated in Subsection (A) herein; from the remaining monies accruing to  
4 the benefit of the "80th Session Projects Account" of the "General  
5 Improvement Fund" as authorized by Section 2 of this Act, the Governor may  
6 direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to effectuate an allocation of  
7 monies for the following purposes:

32 SECTION 4. (A) In the event monies are not available or are estimated

33 not to become available to fully finance all of the projects for which

34 allocations are provided in Subsection (A) of Section 3 of this Act, the

35 Governor shall notify the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and at the same



1 time he shall notify the Arkansas Legislative Council of the projects in  
2 Subsection (A) of Section 3 of this Act for which financing shall be made  
3 available, and shall specify the projects for which funding is approved and  
4 the priorities to be followed in providing funds for each such project.

5 (B) In the event sufficient monies are not available or are estimated  
6 not to become available to fully finance all of the projects for which  
7 allocations are provided in Subsection (B) of Section 3 of this Act, the  
8 Governor shall notify the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and at the same  
9 time shall notify the Arkansas Legislative Council of the projects in  
10 Subsection (B) of Section 3 of this Act for which financing shall be made  
11 available, and shall specify the projects for which funding is approved and  
12 the priorities to be followed in providing funds for each such project.

13 (C) In the event sufficient monies are not available or are estimated  
14 not to become available to fully finance all of the projects for which  
15 allocations are provided in Subsection (C) of Section 3 of this Act, the  
16 Governor shall notify the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and at the same  
17 time notify the Arkansas Legislative Council of the projects in Subsection  
18 (C) of Section 3 of this Act for which financing shall be made available, and  
19 shall specify the projects for which funding is approved and the priorities  
20 to be followed in providing funds for each such project.

22 SECTION 5. Any enactment of the 80th General Assembly appropriating or  
23 allocating funds to be payable from the "General Improvement Fund", for which  
24 a specific allocation of funds is authorized in Section 3 of this Act, shall  
25 be deemed to be payable from the "80th Session Projects Account" within the  
26 "General Improvement Fund" unless a specific intent is otherwise provided by  
27 law. Any enactment of the 80th General Assembly appropriating funds payable  
28 from the General Improvement Fund which is not enumerated in this Act shall  
29 not be financed from monies accruing to the 80th Session Projects Account.  
30 Provided that monies reappropriated by the 80th General Assembly for projects  
31 for which appropriations were made by the 79th General Assembly, which are  
32 not enumerated in this Act and which are made payable from the "General  
33 Improvement Fund", shall be payable from the "79th Session Projects Account"  
34 of the "General Improvement Fund" and allowances shall be made therefore in  
35 arriving at the uncommitted and unobligated balance of monies in the "General

1 Improvement Fund" before making transfers therefrom to the "80th Session  
2 Projects Account", as authorized by this Act.

3

4 SECTION 6. Distribution of funds for constructing and equipping the  
5 radiation therapy institutes specified herein, shall be contingent upon the  
6 provision of matching funds, including those monies previously raised but not  
7 previously used to match state funds, on a dollar by dollar basis on behalf  
8 of each such radiation therapy institute.

9

10 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
11 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
12 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13

14 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
15 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
16 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
17 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
18 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

19

20 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
21 with this Act are hereby repealed.

22

23 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined that  
24 the Eightieth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session has considered and  
25 enacted appropriations for construction projects and other programs to be  
26 financed from the accumulated surplus and reserve funds available in the  
27 State Treasury; that the total of the enacted appropriations exceed the  
28 estimated available fund and that the immediate passage of this Act is  
29 necessary to establish a method of providing for the orderly financing and a  
30 system of priority for the financing of such projects. Therefore, an  
31 emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the  
32 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in  
33 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
